# REGISTRATION

1. Register online at Leggiero Software https://omta.leggierosw.com

2. Log in to your account, then click on FESTIVALS in the menu bar on the left.

3. Choose your district.

4. Click on the name of the festival for which you would like to register. Once you have registered at least one student, a registration link for that event will be available on your Teacher Home Page. If you are registered for several events at once, you may need to scroll down your Teacher Home Page to see all of them.

5. **Please input students' names properly and correctly**. (e.g. Jane Smith is correct; jane smith and JANE SMITH are not). First and last names only. All certificates and trophies are automatically generated based upon the information you provide in the Leggiero database. If you misspell a student's name during registration, his/her trophy or certificate will bear that incorrect spelling. *We will not issue substitute certificates/trophies in these circumstances*. If you notice that you spelled a student name incorrectly, you may edit the spelling at any time before the chairman has downloaded the programs for printing.

6. You may make changes to your student registrations up until midnight of the registration deadline.

7. When you have completed your registration, print a copy of the invoice and registration summary for your records.

8. Write *one check* to **OMTA** for the total due.

- \$32.00 per student
- Please note: All fees are **NON-REFUNDABLE**

## **TEACHER/MONITOR REQUIREMENTS**

- All participating teachers are required to either serve personally as a monitor or to arrange for a monitor to serve in their stead.
- Suggested substitutes include fellow teachers and capable students.
- You may sign up to monitor online through Leggiero as soon as the schedule has been posted.
- Teachers (or their substitutes) are required to monitor one recital.

## STUDENT ELIGIBILITY

- Must have studied with a current OMTA teacher for a minimum of **6 months**.
- Must not be a college graduate.
- Must not have reached 20th birthday on or before the first day of the festival.

#### **TEACHER ELIGIBILITY**

- Must be an OMTA member in good standing.
- Must be **available to volunteer/monitor/arrange for a substitute monitor** for part of the festival.
- For non-members of OMTA, there is an additional \$35 teacher fee. Please contact the chair for registration.

#### **REPERTOIRE REQUIREMENTS**

- All acoustic instruments, voice, duets and small chamber groups are welcome.
- Repertoire may be from any genre of music including Classical and Jazz. No Era restrictions and as outlined by the Syllabus guidelines.
- Repertoire must be performed from memory (scores are ok for chamber groups only, not duets)
- Arrangements are welcome.
- Please bring your own accompanist if playing an instrument other than piano.
- Literature may not be repeated from one year to the next by the same student.

## FESTIVAL FORMAT

- The East Portland Honors Recital is a non-competitive event. Students do not compete against one another.
- We want to celebrate talented students by giving them a stage to share their beautiful music! Participants will be chosen by their teachers and given the opportunity to perform their chosen program with others in a one-hour recital.
- Each participating teacher may enter one to two of their own students who they feel should be honored with this recital.
- All participants will receive a certificate of successful participation at the end of each recital.

#### TIME ALLOWANCES

- Students in categories Elementary I and II will be allowed 5 minutes playing time.
- Students in categories Junior and Senior will be allowed 7 minutes playing time.

#### PHOTOGRAPHY

• Parents are only permitted to photograph/video their own children.
